
## Disinfecting Products



## QT Plus

The District ensures adherence to hygiene, cleaning and disinfection requirements of the NYSED Office of Facilities Cleaning, the CDC and NYSDOH. The District uses state DEC and EPA registered household disinfectants approved for use against COVID-19.

These products have been used in the District for 20+ years



EPA registered hospital grade cleaner and disinfectants

We utilize an automated chemical dilution system, ensuring that we don't put more product on surfaces, in solution, or in the air than absolutely necessary.

# Spray Bottles provided for staff



Re-Juv-Nal (or QT Plus) will be provided to the classrooms in a labelled pre-mixed spray bottle, diluted (mixed with water) and ready for use.

If you need supplies, please see your head custodian.

# DO

- Read all labels before use
- Gather needed supplies
- Ask for help or a demonstration if you need it
- Use soap and water to clean surfaces
- Be vigilant about eating surfaces for students with food allergies -use only soap and water [or Suprox (cleaner) for elementary schools –see head Custodian if needed]
- Use wipes instead of Re-Juv-Nal or QT Plus in the presence of students and on items such as computers, key boards & phones.

# Don't

- ▶ Use in the presence of students
- ▶ Use on surfaces used for eating –USE soap & water
- ▶ Use a lot of the product...a little mist goes a long way
- ▶ Combine this product with other products
- ▶ Use on fabrics or soft surfaces
- ▶ Use on anything students may put in their mouths; these should be washed with soap & water (toys, pencils, etc.)

# Steps for use of disinfectants: Re-Juv-Nal or QT Plus

- ▶ Surfaces should be clear of items.
- ▶ Adjust the nozzle on the sprayer of the spray bottle to provide a fine mist, not a stream.
- ▶ It should only take 2-3 minutes to spray with a light mist on typical desks, chairs and/or common touch surfaces to disinfect them.
- ▶ Spray a light mist away from your body approximately 8-10" from the surface, do not spray where product will be inhaled by others.
- ▶ Do not soak the surface, it is not necessary.
- ▶ Let it stay on surface for approximately 10 minutes until dry. Any area not naturally dried after 10 minutes, wipe dry with a paper towel.
- ▶ It is recommended to your wash hands with soap & water after use. If you develop an irritation, PPE should be used (gloves-supplies sent to custodians)
- ▶ You can also spray into a paper towel and wipe a hard surface or use in a bucket to apply to surfaces.

# Summary

Be cautious with any chemicals

Don't use with students present

See your head custodian if you need  
assistance or products

Use soap and water to clean, wipes  
whenever possible, and ReJuvNal or  
QT Plus for disinfecting when 10+  
minutes are available
