



# COLLEGE PLANNING CALENDAR – SENIOR YEAR



## JULY/AUGUST

- Be mindful of deadlines for colleges and standardized tests
- Continue to work on [Common App](#)
- Sign up for fall [ACTs](#) (given in September, October & December(not SHS)) and/or [SATs](#) (given in October, November (not MHS) & December)
- Finalize college essay(s)
- Create [FAFSA](#) user account
- Update and revise your list of potential schools in [Naviance](#)
- Potential DI or DII College Athletes register with [NCAA](#) and request transcript through Counseling Office
- Create [FSA](#) ID for student and parents to use for creating a [FAFSA](#) account.

## SEPTEMBER

- Be mindful of deadlines
- Attend Senior Night for students and parents (including information on Financial Aid)
- Schedule Senior Conference with your counselor before turning in Transcript Release Forms
- Work on [Common App](#)
- Sign up for fall ACTs and/or SATs
- Prepare for [ACTs](#) and/or [SATs](#)
- Attend [college rep visits](#)
- Secure teacher letters of recommendation
- Submit [Transcript Release Forms](#) for Early Decision/Early Action (3-4 weeks ahead of 1<sup>st</sup> due date)
- Have official test scores sent 30 days before due date

## OCTOBER

- Be mindful of deadlines
- Prepare for [ACTs](#) and/or [SATs](#)
- Attend [college rep visits](#)
- Secure teacher letters of recommendation
- Work on College Applications
- Submit [Transcript Release Forms](#) for Early Decision/Early Action (3-4 weeks ahead of 1<sup>st</sup> due date)
- Have official test scores from [ACT](#) and or [SAT](#) sent
- Create [FSA ID](#) for student and parents to use for FAFSA account
- Student and parents complete FAFSA on-line after October 1<sup>st</sup> at [www.FAFSA.ed.gov](http://www.FAFSA.ed.gov)

## NOVEMBER

- Be mindful of deadlines; do not wait until the last minute
- Prepare for [ACTs](#) and/or [SATs](#)
- Attend [college rep visits](#)
- Follow up on teacher letters of recommendation
- Work on College Applications
- Submit [Transcript Release Forms](#) for Early Decision/Early Action
- Have official test scores from [ACT](#) and/or [SAT](#) sent
