TAX WARRANT

BE IT RESOLVED that the valuation of the property comprising Pittsford Central School District, State of New York, Counties of Monroe and Ontario, as shown on the District Assessment rolls, and certified by the respective assessors of the towns in the district be approved; THAT a sum not to exceed \$84,971,450 be levied in the form of a tax on the property set forth on the aforementioned assessment rolls; that the Board of Education has retained up to \$1,250,000 in unexpended surplus funds and, in compliance with the law, such unexpended surplus funds have been applied in determining the amount of the school tax levy; and that the warrant therefore and the rolls thereof, be executed by a majority of the members of the Board of Education; and that the receiver of taxes be authorized to collect taxes on said warrant for a period of 30

days, beginning September 1, 2011, without penalty, and for a period of 31 days thereafter with a two percent (2%) penalty, as provided by the statute.
