How to submit for community service credit while schools are closed for grades 6-12:

- Go to pittsfordschools.org/communityservice and click on Forms for Credit
- Fill out form, print (not an online process)
- Parents sign form to verify 10 hours or less of volunteer work
- Email form to Mrs. Legg at michelle_legg@pittsford.monroe.edu
- If over 10 hours, send email from supervisor **together with completed form** directly to Mrs. Legg
