1.	"I am a Vietnamese revolutionary and statesman. I am most famous for leading an independence movement against France, and later defeating the United States to establish the communist-governed Democratic Republic of Vietnam."	Ho Chi Minh
2.	"I am a South African nationalist leader. I was a leader of the African National Congress, and spent 27 years in jail for my efforts to end apartheid. In 1994, I was the first President of South Africa to be elected in fully-representative democratic elections."	Nelson Mandela
3.	"I am a major political and spiritual leader of India and the Indian independence movement. I encouraged non-violent civil disobedience to help gain India's independence from Britain."	Mahatmas Gandhi
4.	"I am an English-born businessman and imperialist in South Africa. I founded the DeBeers diamond company. I firmly believe in the superiority of Europeans over Africans, and named the country "Rhodesia" after myself."	Cecil Rhodes
5.	"I am a Chinese leader of the Nationalist party who battled the Communist party for control of China. My followers and I were eventually forced to retreat to the island of Taiwan."	Jiang Jieshi (Chiang Kai-Shek)
6.	"I am an African Nationalist leader who was the first Prime Minister and President of Kenya."	Jomo Kenyatta
7.	"I was the de facto leader of the People's Republic of China from the late 1970s to the early 1990s. One of my famous programs was the Four Modernizations, which sought to improve Chinese agriculture, industry, science/technology, and the military. I allowed China's economy to become more capitalist, but I did not allow individual rights (as evidenced by the Tiananmen Square massacre)."	Deng Xioping
8.	"I am an American naval admiral who threatened Japan with military force unless they opened trade with the U.S. in 1854."	Commodore Matthew Perry
9.	"I am a former Haitian slave who led a revolution against France, which led to the establishment of the independent black state of Haiti, transforming an entire society of slaves into a free, self-governing people."	Toussaint L'Ouverture
10.	"I am a Chinese Nationalist leader who helped to topple the Qing Dynasty, although I was often exiled outside the country. My 'Three Principles of the People' stressed the importance of democracy, nationalism, and welfare."	(Sun Yat-sen) Sun Yixian

11.	"I am a leader of several independence movements throughout South America. I lead the fight for independence in what are now the countries of Venezuela, Colombia, Ecuador, Peru, Panama, and Bolivia."	Simón Bolívar
12.	"I am an African Nationalist leader. I am the founder and first President of Ghana. I was also a leader of the Pan-African movement."	Kwame Nkrumah
13.	"I am a Cuban politician and socialist revolutionary. I ruled Cuba from 1959 to 2008. The United States did not agree with my communist principles, and we clashed many times, most notably during the Bay of Pigs Invasion and the Cuban Missile Crisis."	Fidel Castro
14.	"I led my Communist Party to victory against the Nationalists in the Chinese Civil War. During my rule, I established the Five Year Plan, the Great Leap Forward, and the Cultural Revolution."	Mao Zedong
15.	"I am a Belgian monarch who made the Congo my personal colony. I ravaged the country of natural resources, especially rubber, and forced the native people into slave labor."	King Leopold II
16.	"I was the leader of the Khmer Rouge in Cambodia that orchestrated a genocide that killed over 2 million people. My goal was to take Cambodia back to year zero and get rid of any westernization."	Pol Pot
17.	"I am an enlightened thinker who believed that the powers of government should be separated into 3 branches. Each branch will keep the other branches from becoming too power."	Baron de Montesquieu
18.	"I am an enlightened thinker who believed that people have natural rights and it is the job of the government to protect these natural rights."	John Locke
19.	"I am an enlightened thinker who wrote the book The Social Contract. I believed that people are good, but corrupted by the evils of society and what is good for everyone is more important than what is good for one person"	Thomas Hobbes
20.	"I am an enlightened despot from Russia. I read enlightenment works of Voltaire and Montesquieu. I built schools, promoted the education of women, and extended religious tolerance. However, I became more repressive after a peasant uprising"	Catherine the Great
21.	"I was a leader during a period of the French Revolution called the Reign of Terror. Tens of thousands of people, including myself eventually, were executed by use of the guillotine."	Maximilien Robespierre
22.	"I am a revolutionary leader of France who overthrew the weak Directory and declared myself Emperor of the French. I was so popular because I helped the French economy, built government-supervised public schools and established a legal code. However, my downfall came when I tried to invade Russia."	Napoleon Bonaparte
