GOAL OF COURSE

In this course you will create a body of work representing:

1. An emerging competence and mastery in artistic skills and techniques in a variety of craft media.
2. Development of sophistication in concept conceptualization
3. Aesthetics in art, based on the Elements and Principles of Art and Color Theory.
4. An ability to communicate about your artistic development and about art in general.

GRADING
