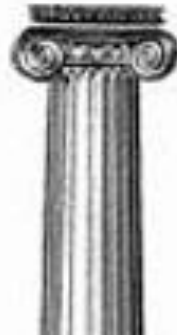

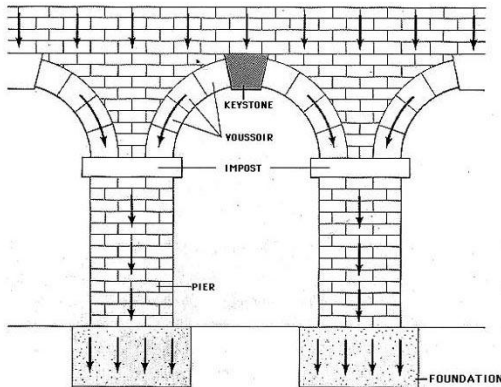

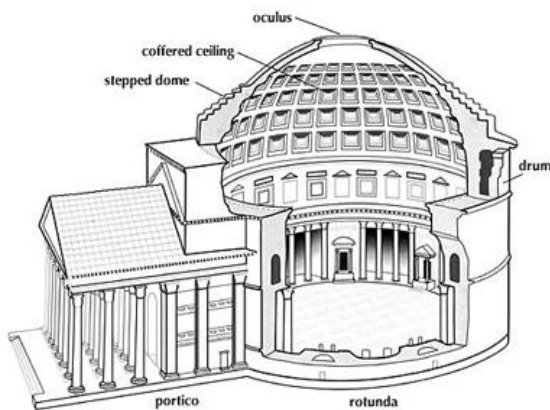

### Arches

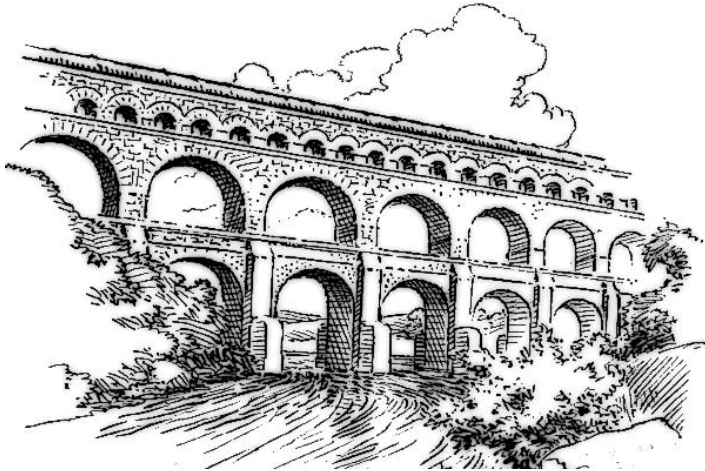

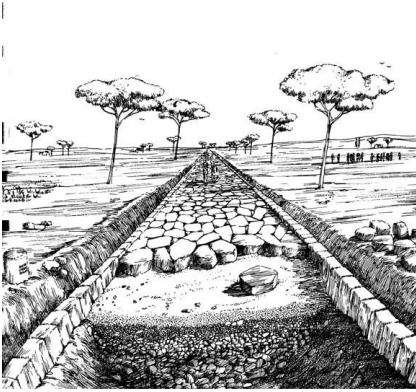
