Studio Art	Hard or Spiral bound sketchbook 9"x 12" with Mixed Media paper - minimum 60 pages, #2 pencils (not mechanical), thin black permanent marker (such as a sharpie), good eraser, 1-gallon size Ziploc bag, pocket folder.
Painting and Drawing I	Portfolio (at least 18"x24"), hard or spiral bound mixed media paper sketchbook minimum 60 pages (max size: 9"x12"), #2 pencils, good eraser.
Painting and Drawing II	Portfolio (at least 18"x24"), hard or spiral bound mixed media sketchbook minimum 60 pages (max size: 9"x12"), #2 pencils and good eraser.
Portfolio	Portfolio (at least 18"x24"), hard or spiral bound multi-media sketchbook minimum 60 pages (max size: 9"x12"), flash drive. Recommended: Pencils, eraser, minimum 24 color set of colored pencils and favorite brand of blank ink pens in various nibs.

College Math	Agenda or planner, three ring binder or notebook/folder for handouts, loose leaf paper, pens (blue or black), pencils, and a TI-Nspire CX calculator (non CAS).

Science Inquiry	Agenda, pens, pencils, all other materials provided.
Earth Science	Agenda, 2" three ring binder, 11 dividers, scientific calculator ex Ti-30 (State regulations prohibit the use of graphing calculators), colored pencils, 4 different colored highlighters, pens, pencils, pencil case that fits into 3 ring binder to hold supplies.
Biology	Agenda, 2" three ring binder with paper, composition book, blue or black pens, pencils, colored pencils, scientific calculator ex Ti-30 (State regulations prohibit the use of graphing calculators).
AP Biology	Agenda, 2" three ring binder with paper or spiral notebook with pockets, blue or black pens, pencils, scientific calculator ex Ti-30 (State regulations prohibit the use of graphing calculators).
Chemistry	Agenda, 1 ½" three ring binder w/ paper, scientific calculator ex Ti-30 (State regulations prohibit the use of graphing calculators), bound composition notebook for laboratory data (cannot be spiral bound), file folder, colored pencils, blue or black pens, pencils.
Physics & AP Physics	Agenda, 2" three ring binder w/ paper or spiral notebook w/ pockets, scientific calculator ex Ti-30 (State regulations prohibit the use of graphing calculators), plastic protractor, small plastic centimeter ruler, blue or black pens, pencils.
