1. Perform a song for your family, pets, or stuffed animals. You can sing, play an instrument, or dance – or all three!
2. Find a song you have never heard before. Listen to it, then draw a picture of what it makes you think of, or how it makes you feel.
3. Take a short walk outside without talking. When you get back inside, write down and describe all of the sounds you heard.
4. Make a musical instrument with things in your house. Create a song for you to play on your new instrument.
5. Listen to your favorite song. Write down, or tell someone why it is your favorite song.
