Seventh grade is a pivotal year in math as the curriculum contains several concepts that are an important foundation for many future math classes. Topics taught in 7th grade math include the number system, equations, inequalities, ratios and proportional relationships, percents, geometry, probability, and statistics. In addition, a unit on Graphing and Monomials is taught in the spring as a prerequisite for Algebra.

CLASS PROCEDURES:

1) There will be **Classwork and Homework Packets** for each unit that should be brought to and from school **DAILY**.



- 2) There will also be a **MATH TEAM** on **Microsoft Teams** where Important Information may be communicated **at times** including but not limited to **assignments**, **announcements**, **class worksheets** and **answer keys**, and **assessments**.
- 3) When you are **absent** please go on to **Microsoft Teams** to view the lesson that you missed and complete the necessary **classwork** and **homework**!
- 4) **Homework** will be given on a **DAILY** basis to practice the new concepts taught that day.
 - Since each day there is a new concept, it is important to complete **each** homework assignment before I build upon it the next day.
 - Students not keeping up with the homework will come in during lunch to complete missing work.

- 1) **ALL** work should be shown **EXACTLY** as modeled in class and on the answer keys.
- 2) **Email me** or **send me a message through Microsoft Teams** ANY TIME that you have a question or need some assistance.

- 2) Use your class notes on a **DAILY** basis when **completing the homework!**
- 3) Get extra help **immediately** when you are confused or have been **absent**.
