Organization is very important to help the year go smoothly. To help us start the year off right we are recommending the following school supplies. Please be sure to check the supply list that you receive in August from your child's teacher for any additional items added over the summer.

For each fourth grade classroom (all labeled with name):

- 1 - 1 subject wide ruled spiral notebook
- 1 black and white composition notebook
- 6 – sturdy two pocket folders – 1 red, 1 yellow, 1 green, 2 blue, 1 orange
- 24 Ticonderoga pencils, sharpened
- 1 good eraser
- 1 pair 5” scissors, pointed tip
- 3 different colored highlighters (1 yellow, 1 orange, 1 blue)
- 3 glue sticks
- 1 pad of Sticky Notes (3” X 3” square)
- 2 pens (4H & 4S red; 4M green)
- Small protractor – *to be kept at home* for homework
- Rectangular 5x8 plastic pencil box for loose items (*no larger please as they do not fit in desks*)
- 1 LARGE boxes of tissues
- Headphones/ear buds in a labeled baggie (will be returned in June)

Classroom Specific Supplies:

- 1 box of 12 sharpened colored pencils - 4M & 4H
- One box of 24 Crayons (*no more please, as they do not fit in our desks*) -4S
- Ruler – 4H

- Two, 1.5 inch, 3-ring binders – 4H, 4M
- One purple folder – 4S & 4M
