Choose from the activities listed below as a way to practice your Foundations trick words.

<p><b>Build a Pyramid</b> Write the 1st letter of your word. Then on the next line write the next 2 letters. Continue with this pattern until you have spelled the whole word.</p> <p>b bi big</p>	<p><b>Flash Writing</b> In a dark room, use a flash-light to write your word study words. Repeat this 3 times. Don't forget to say the letters out loud as you write.</p>	<p><b>Minute to Win It</b> See how many times you can write your word study words in 1 minute. Have a parent call out the word &amp; set the timer for 1 minute. How many times can you write it? Repeat with each word study word.</p>	<p><b>Typerific</b> Use a computer to type your word study words. Get your creative juices flowing and make your words different colors, fonts, and sizes!</p>
<p><b>ABC Order</b> Write your spelling words in alphabetical order.</p>	<p><b>Memory</b> Make 2 sets of flashcards with your word study words. Find a partner &amp; play a game of word study memory. Flip the cards over, if you find a match, you keep it! The one with the most matches wins!</p>	<p><b>Chalk the Walk</b> With a parent's permission, write your word study words outside on your driveway. <u>OR</u> Write your words on a blackboard or whiteboard inside your house.</p>	<p><b>Magazine Madness</b> Search through a magazine or a newspaper to locate the letter needed to spell your word study words. Glue the letters to a sheet of paper.</p>
<p><b>Sky Writing</b> Spray some shaving cream on a cookie sheet. Spread it out. Write your word study words with your finger. Don't forget to say each letter out loud as you write.</p>	<p><b>Fancy Nancy Word Work</b> Write your word study words using fancy letters. You can write you words in different colors, bubble letters, curly cues or any other design.</p>	<p><b>Colored Vowels</b> Write each word in crayon or marker. Use a DIFFERENT color for the vowels.</p>	<p><b>Write a Letter</b> Write a letter to a family member. Use at least 10 of your word study words. Circle your word study words in your letter when you are finished.</p>
